### **DENMARK (and the FAEROE ISLANDS)**

Military vehicles subject to the terms of International Agreements.

### **ESTONIA**

Military vehicles subject to the terms of International Agreements.

### **FRANCE (and MONACO)**

Military vehicles subject to the terms of International Agreements.

### **UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN and NORTHERN IRELAND (and the CHANNEL ISLANDS and the ISLE OF MAN; and GIBRALTAR)**

Military vehicles subject to the terms of International Agreements.

### **GREECE**

1. Vehicles belonging to military and civil personnel governed by International Agreements.
2. Vehicles belonging to intergovernmental organisations.

### **ITALY**

Vehicles belonging to military forces governed by International Agreements ("AFI" plates).

### **LITHUANIA**

Military vehicles subject to the terms of International Agreements.

**LATVIA**

Military vehicles subject to the terms of International Agreements.

**MALTA**

Military vehicles subject to the terms of International Agreements.

**THE NETHERLANDS**

1. Private vehicles belonging to Dutch military personnel and their families stationed in Germany.
2. Vehicles belonging to German military personnel stationed in the Netherlands.
3. Vehicles belonging to persons attached to Headquarters Allied Forces Central Europe.
4. Service vehicles of the NATO armed forces.

**PORTUGAL**

1. Agricultural machines and motorised mechanical equipment for which registration plates are not required under Portuguese Law.
2. Vehicles belonging to foreign States and to International Organisations of which Portugal is a Member State: (white plates - red figures, preceded by the letters "CD" or "FM").
3. Vehicles belonging to the Portuguese State - (black plates - white figures, preceded by the letters "AM", "AP", "EP", "ME", "MG" or "MX", according to the Government department concerned).

**POLAND**

Military vehicles subject to the terms of International Agreements.

**ROMANIA**

Military vehicles subject to the terms of International Agreements.
